## **Have a say on road plans**

People can see outline plans for improvements to Narborough Road South and give their feedback on the ideas.

The plans will be on show at Braunstone Civic Centre until January 5 and residents can speak out about what they think could be done to improve the area.

Leicestershire County Council exhibited the plans last week on a community bus which was parked at various points along Narborough Road South service roads.

More than 200 residents turned up to see the plans during the three-day period.

Initial ideas for the £1.5 million project include landscaping areas to the side of the road and replacing the wire mesh fence.

Nicholas Rushton, Deputy Leader of the County Council, said: "We are extremely pleased with the number of people who turned up to have their say on the community bus. We want to encourage as many people as possible to go along to the Civic Centre and see what they think of the plans.

"This route is a significant gateway into the city, and improving it will not only benefit the residents living close by, but potentially thousands of others who use it every day."
