

**Leicestershire Local Area Agreement**

**Safer Communities Block**

**Revised Outcome Framework 2007/08**

**Outcome 1 - Reduce Crime**

- **Reduce overall crime by 17.1% by March 2008**
- **Reduce domestic violence** (Reward Target)  
(Also contributes to reducing re-offending indicator)
- **To increase reporting of hate crime and to reduce reported hate crime in year 3**
  
- **Reduce the proportion of adult and young offenders and prolific offenders and other priority offenders who re-offend (new mandatory indicator)**
  
- **Reduction in offending by PPOs**
  
- **Increase the %age of offenders living in settled and suitable accommodation at the end of their order or licence (baselining and target development to be completed by March 2007).**
  
- **Increase the %age of offenders in employment for 4 weeks** (shared with Economic Development Block.)

**Outcome 2 - Build Respect in Communities and Reduce Anti-social Behaviour**

- **Reduce the rate of increase in recorded ASB by x% (based on a common recording system)**
  
- **Increase in percentage of people who feel informed about what is being done to tackle ASB in their local area.**
  
- **Increased percentage of people who feel that parents in their local area are made to take responsibility for the behaviour of their children**
  
- **Increased percentage of people who feel that people in their area treat them with respect and consideration**

- **Reduce people's perceptions of ASB as a problem (using the 7 categories stated in the survey)**

**Outcome 3 - Reduce the Harm Caused by Illegal Drugs and Misuse of Alcohol to Individuals, Families and the Community**

- **Increase the percentage of problematic drugs users in treatment**
- **Increase the number of Class A Drugs Seizures**
- **Reduce public perception of local drug dealing and drug use as a problem**
- **To reduce levels of alcohol related disorder in town centres**

**Outcome 4 - Youth Crime Prevention**  
(Shared with C&YP Block)

- **Reduction in first time entrants to criminal justice system**
- **Increase in proportion of young people in receipt of a reprimand prevented from re-offending** (also contributes to reduction in re-offending indicator)

**Outcome 5 - Re-assure the Public, Reducing the Fear of Crime and Improve Confidence in the criminal Justice System**

**Outcome 6 – Reduce Vulnerability in Priority Neighbourhoods**
