**BREACH OF CONDITION NOTICE**

**Issued By: Leicestershire County Council**

1. **This is a formal notice** which is issued by the Council, under section 187A of the above Act, because they consider that a condition imposed on a grant of planning permission relating to the land described in paragraph 2. below has not been complied with. The Council consider that you should be required to comply with the condition specified in this notice.

2. **The land affected by the notice**

Acresford Quarry, Acresford Road, Donisthorpe  
in the County of Leicestershire shown edged red on the plan attached to this Notice.

3. **The Relevant Planning Permission**

to which this Notice relates is the permission granted by the Council on 27<sup>th</sup> May 2002 for the restoration of former mineral workings by the importation of subsoils and the creation of a new vehicular access at Acresford Quarry, Acresford Road, Donisthorpe ref. No. 2001/0451/7

4. **The Breach of Condition**

The following condition has not been complied with:

Condition No. 12 which states:

"Prior to the commencement of tipping, wheel cleaning facilities shall be provided within the site in a location and to specifications that have been agreed in writing by the Director of Planning and Transportation and thereafter the wheel cleaning facilities shall be maintained and used by all vehicles leaving the site as necessary so as to prevent mud and detritus being carried out onto the highway"

5. **What you are required to do in relation to the breach of condition**

As the person responsible for the breach of condition specified in paragraph 4 of this Notice, you are required to comply with the stated condition by taking the following steps:

Cease the importation of sub soil and soil material until such time as the details of the location and specifications of the wheel cleaning facilities have been agreed in writing with the Director of Community Services and thereafter implemented and used so as to prevent mud and detritus being carried onto the highway,

Time for compliance: 30 days after the Notice takes effect
