BROOKSBY QUARRY – PROPOSED LANDFILL SITE

Following receipt of a letter dated 25th September from Mr David Parsons I am writing to convey the feelings of a significant number of my constituents within close proximity to the proposed Brooksby landfill site.

From the very many letters I have received you should be aware of the concern of the local residents with regard to the increase in traffic volume on the A607; the possible pollution of the Rearsby Brooke and the surrounding area; airborne pollutants and the very real threat of leaching of liquid pollutants due to the shallow nature of the site and the porous underlying material.

When the original proposal to extract aggregates from this site was being discussed we were assured that the site would be restored to a scenic landscape in keeping with the area and landfill was not an option.

I would be grateful if you would note the very serious concerns of my constituents to these proposals and acknowledge that these very real concerns will be taken into account before any decisions are taken.
