ACTIVITIES

Beaumanor Park Outdoor Education Centre offers many activities and organised events, all closely related to the requirements of the National Curriculum. The range of activities includes World War II, Victorians, I.C.T. Numeracy, Maths Challenge, Nature, Canoeing, Climbing, Orienteering, Fitness, Nursery Rhymes and Challenge Days.



LOCATION

Beaumanor Park Outdoor Education Centre is situated in the grounds of Beaumanor Park adjacent to Beaumanor Hall. It is located in the village of Woodhouse surrounded by 30 acres of gardens and parkland. The grounds include a small wood with mature specimen trees, a stream, pond and a formal garden.



USAGE

Beaumanor Park Outdoor Education Centre grounds are open throughout the year to children from Leicestershire schools and colleges and to groups from beyond Leicestershire. At weekends and holidays voluntary groups such as scouts, guides and church groups make use of the facilities. Special discounted offers are available throughout the winter months.

ACCOMMODATION

There are five residential cabins in the grounds which can accommodate up to 106 in total. All the cabins benefit from central heating and most are double glazed. The sleeping accommodation is in dormitory style and there is a common room and kitchen in each cabin. One of the cabins has been equipped to enable people with disabilities to use the site. Throughout the summer months there is an opportunity to camp in the grounds as an alternative to our cabin accommodation.

STAFFING

Beaumanor Park Outdoor Education Centre is staffed by qualified, experienced teachers and instructors who are employed to lead specific activities.

FACILITIES

Beaumanor Park Outdoor Education Centre offers a wide variety of facilities in addition to the cabins. These include four base rooms of varying size, a sports hall, an adventure playground, a high ropes course and a drying room. There is an orienteering course set out in the grounds which can be used by visiting groups. A shop is situated on site selling gifts and confectionery.

CATERING

Each cabin has a comprehensively equipped kitchen for groups wishing to operate on a self-catering basis. Alternatively, during the week only, all meals can be provided by our catering staff. The evening meal is served in a number of attractive dining areas, including the impressive Victorian dining room in Beaumanor Hall.
