

**THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(BIRSTALL PARK AND RIDE)  
COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2009**

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
AND THE ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

---

The Leicestershire County Council, in this Order called "the Acquiring Authority", hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the Acquiring Authority is, under Section 40 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby authorised to purchase compulsorily the land described in paragraph 2 for the purposes of:-
  - i. relieving congestion of traffic by providing off street parking places consisting of a 1000 space park and ride facility with terminus building together with means of entrance to and egress from them, in the Parish of Birstall, in the District of Charnwood, in the County of Leicestershire.
2. (1) The land authorised to be purchased compulsorily under this order is the land described in the Schedule and is delineated and shown coloured pink on a map consisting of one sheet numbered 0018/M/019, prepared in duplicate, sealed with the Common Seal of the Acquiring Authority and marked "Map referred to in the Leicestershire County Council (Birstall Park and Ride) Compulsory Purchase Order 2009". One duplicate of the map is deposited in the offices of the Acquiring Authority and the other is deposited in the offices of the Secretary of State for Transport.
3. Parts II and III of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 are hereby incorporated with this Order subject to the modifications that references to the said Parts of the said Schedule to the undertaking shall be construed as references to any building or work constructed or to be constructed on that part of the land authorised to be purchased on the said map or, as the case may be, on the land over which new rights are authorised to be acquired.
