COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2009**

COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND IN BIRSTALL

Notice is hereby given that the Leicestershire County Council made the Leicestershire County Council (Birstall Park and Ride) Compulsory Purchase Order under Section 40 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Acquisition of Land Act 1981. It is about to submit this Order to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation and if confirmed the Order will authorise the Leicestershire County Council to purchase compulsorily the land described below for the purpose of:-

relieving congestion of traffic by providing off street parking places consisting of a 1000 space park and ride facility with terminus building together with means of entrance to and egress from them, in the Parish of Birstall, in the District of Charnwood, in the County of Leicestershire.
