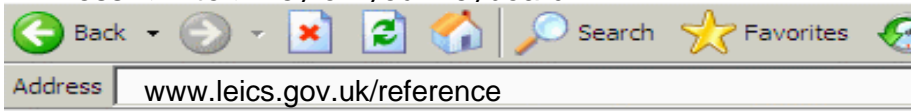




Step 1: Log on to the Libraries webpage

- Open the Web browser (Internet Explorer)
- Click once anywhere in the Address bar
- Press <delete> key
- Type www.leics.gov.uk/reference
- Press <Enter> key on your keyboard



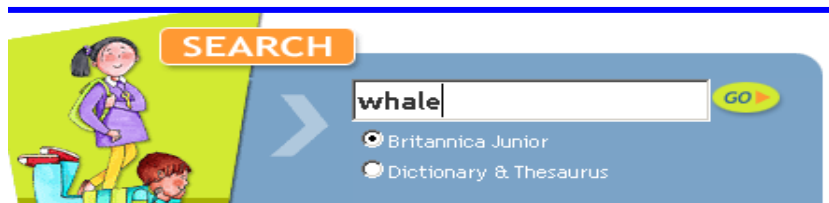

Step 4: Performing a search

- Click in the search box and type **whale**
- Click on **GO** to perform a search



Search examples to try:

For biography articles type **nelson mandela** in the search box and click **GO**:

- Wait for the search results page to load
- Browse through the search results page
- Point and click on any [text](#) or [image](#) links
- Wait for the page to load on the link you have clicked
