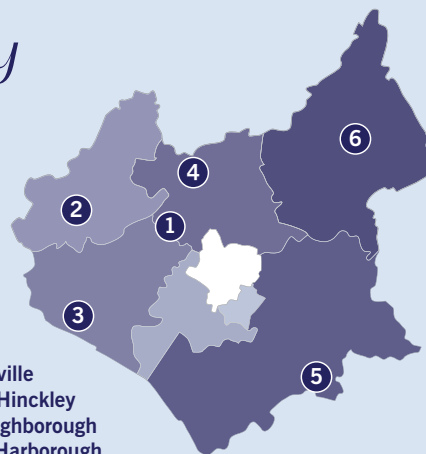

What is a Naming Ceremony?

A naming ceremony is a celebration of the birth of your child or the welcoming of an adopted/ step child into the family. It is also an opportunity to declare, before family and friends, your promise to be as good a parent as you can, including all of those who will be involved in the child's development.



Elements of a Naming Ceremony include:

- ❖ Introduction and welcome
- ❖ A reading
- ❖ Naming of the child
- ❖ Parents' promises
- ❖ Supporting adults' promises
- ❖ Grandparents' promises
- ❖ Signing of the commemorative certificate
- ❖ Closing words



Commitment Ceremony

Commitment ceremonies offer an opportunity for you to make a personal, public declaration of your life-long love and commitment to your partner. They are suitable for couples who cannot or choose not to marry legally, or for same-sex couples who cannot or choose not to form a civil partnership.

As these ceremonies are so personal they are only available as a bespoke option. Please contact our Ceremony Coordinator for further information.

Who Can Renew Their Vows?

Suitable for any couple wishing to renew their vows in a unique and personal ceremony but most often associated with a special anniversary, after times of difficulty or to share with friends and family on return from getting married abroad.

Any married couple or civil partners, of any age and who have been together for any length of time can arrange a Renewal of Vows Ceremony. You do not have to live in Leicestershire to arrange a ceremony within the county.

Elements of Our Renewal of Vows Ceremony include:

- ❖ Introduction and welcome
- ❖ Acknowledgement of family
- ❖ Renewal of vows
- ❖ Exchange of new rings or rededication of current rings
- ❖ A reading
- ❖ Signing of commemorative certificate
- ❖ Closing words



Choosing Your Ceremony and Location...

Leicestershire Registration Service offers two types of ceremony;

1. Standard Ceremony

(only available at Leicestershire Ceremony Rooms)

The standard ceremony does not include the option of a pre-ceremony meeting with your Celebrant, however your Celebrant will contact you prior to your ceremony either by telephone or email to confirm final arrangements.

2. Bespoke Ceremony

(available at Leicestershire Ceremony Rooms or at any of our approved premises)

The Bespoke Ceremony offers the chance of a greater degree of personal choice. It includes all of the elements within the Standard Ceremony but has a greater choice of promises or the option for you to write your own promises and include extra readings.

The Bespoke Ceremony offers you the chance of a pre-ceremony meeting with your Celebrant to help you devise your ceremony according to your own wishes. This option also allows up to two children to be named within one Naming Ceremony.

How to Book a Ceremony

For all Ceremonies

Naming Ceremony

- ❖ Provide a copy of your child's birth certificate prior to your ceremony

Renewal of Vows Ceremony

- ❖ Provide a copy of your marriage certificate or your Civil Partnership certificate prior to your ceremony
