"Our Graffiti wall looks really cool."

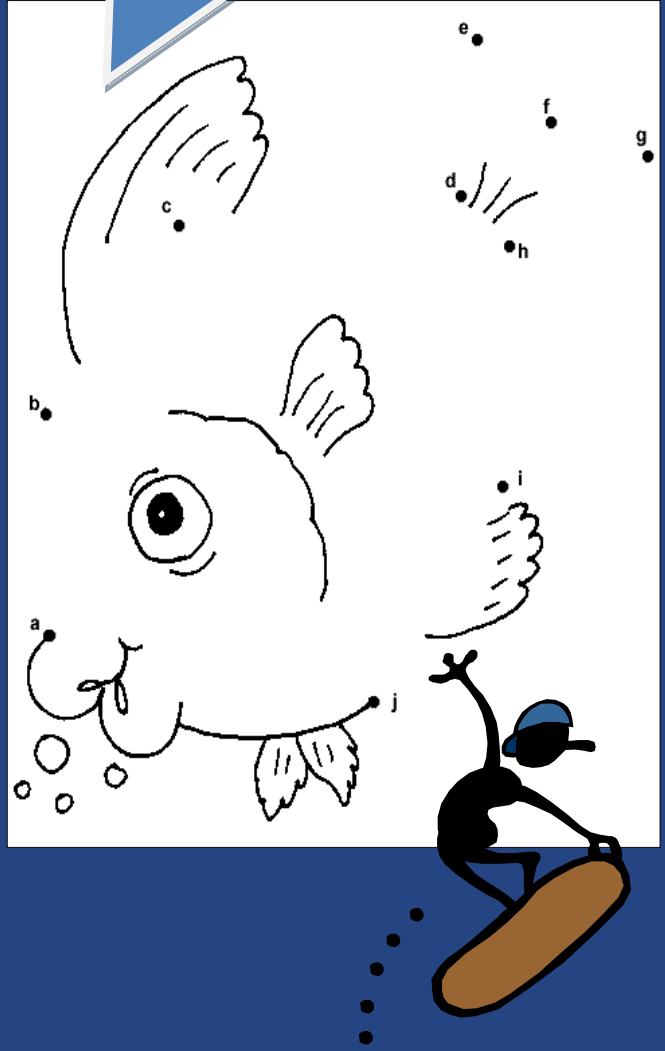


"I made new friends and designed a cool baseball cap. I've really enjoyed this week."

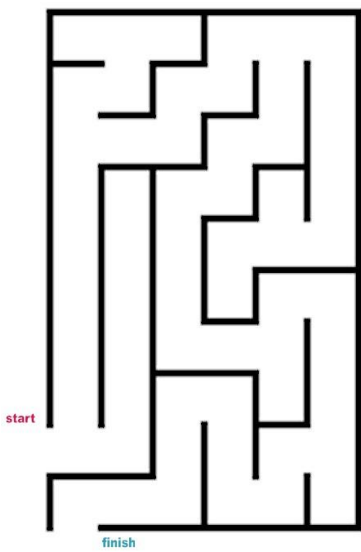
