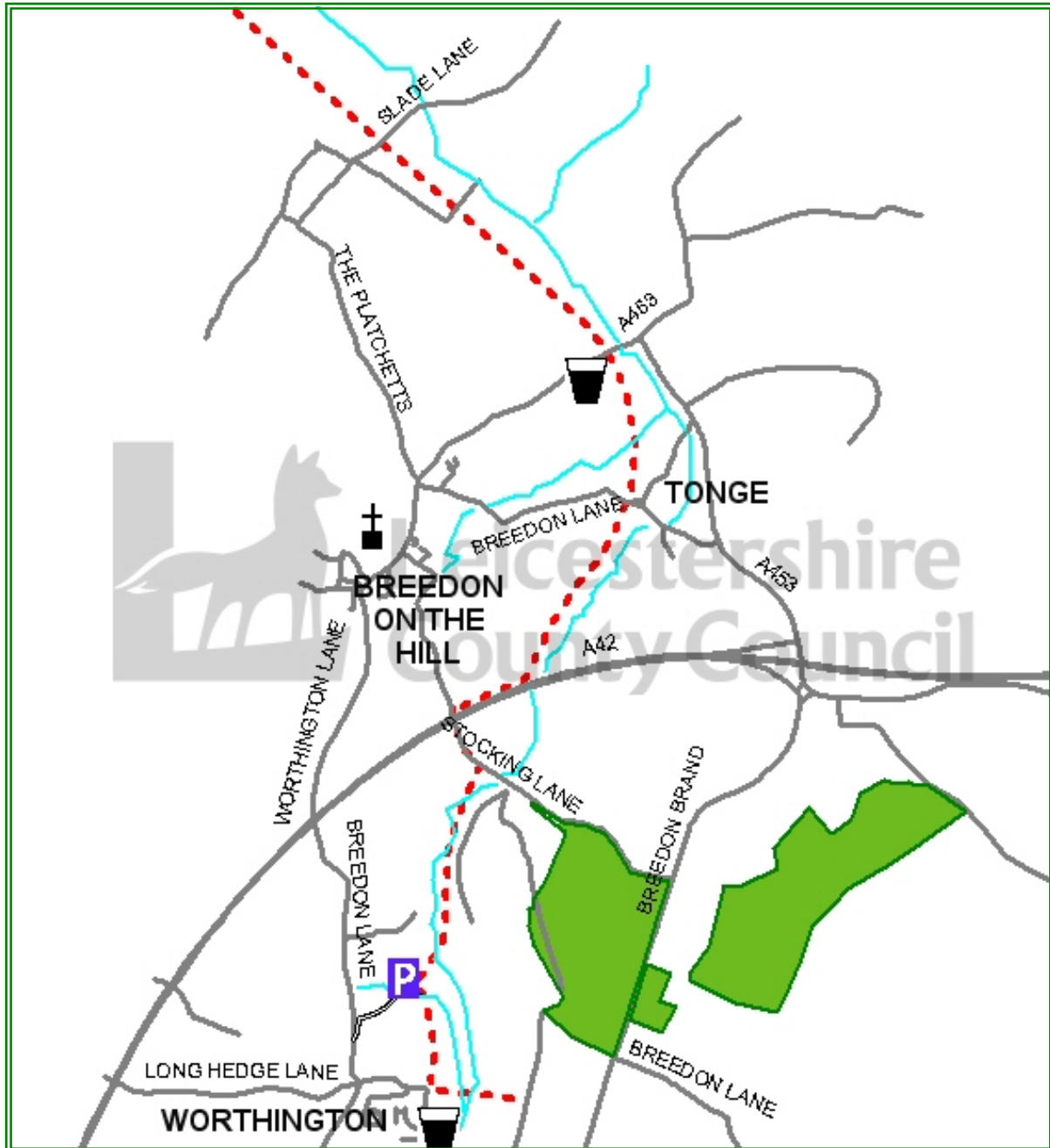




Cloud Trail

Did you know?

This route forms part of the National Cycle Network (NCN) 6 that extends to Loughborough and beyond. For information on the entire route contact Sustrans.

The National Cycle Network offers 9,500 miles of signed, safe and attractive cycle routes in the UK. One third of the Network is on traffic-free paths, with the rest on quiet minor roads and traffic-calmed streets. The route makes use of disused railway lines, canal towpaths, riversides and parks, they are free and open for use by walkers and cyclists and those with prams and wheelchairs.
