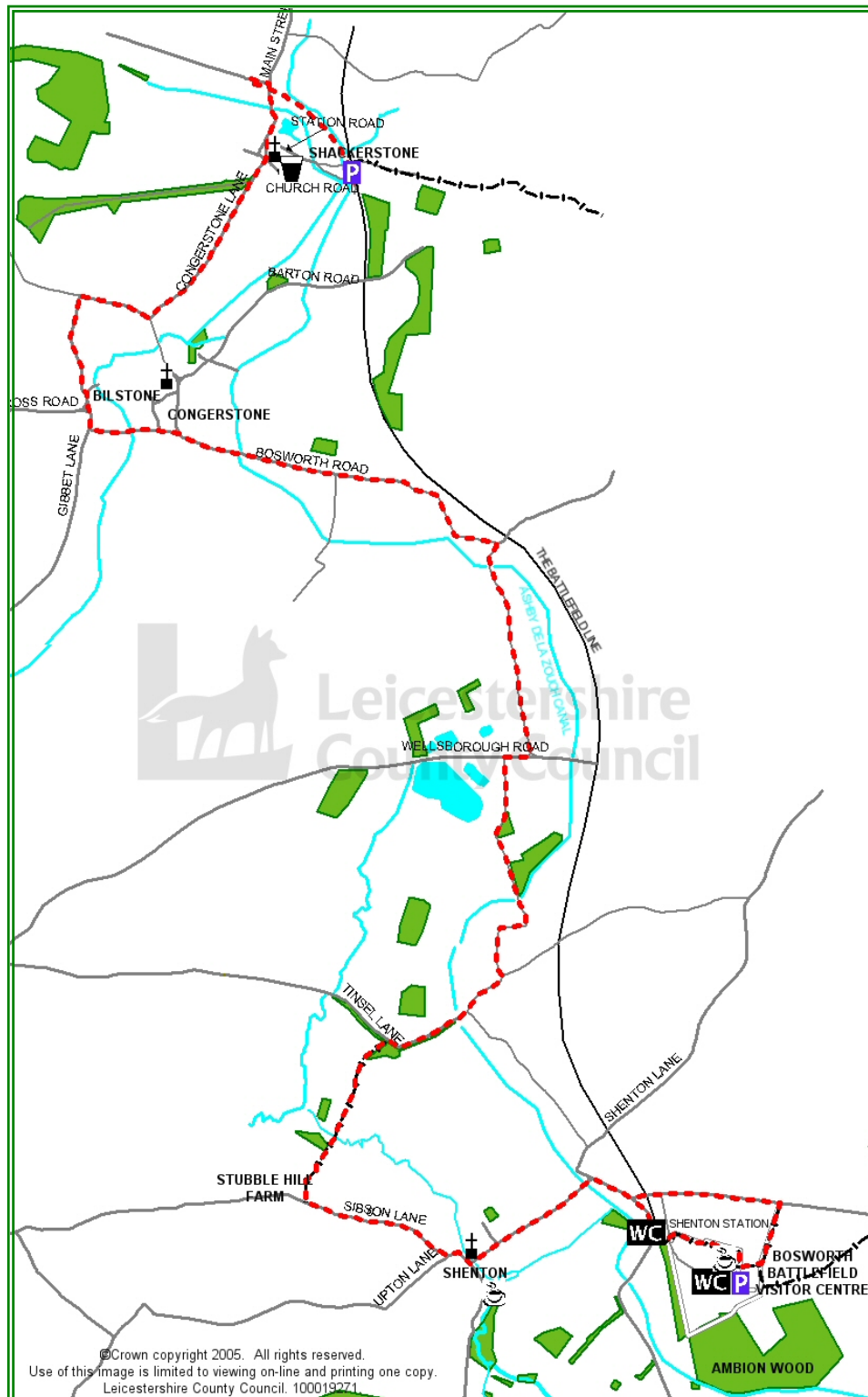


# Cycle & Steam - Bosworth

## Worth a Visit

Market Bosworth is a small, attractive and historically interesting town with a population of just over 2,000. The town centre is a conservation area with many old buildings surrounding the Market Place. There are a number of shops, pubs and restaurants, three churches and three schools.

The right to hold a market in the town goes back to the seventeenth century when a Charter was granted. The Market operates every Wednesday with a variety of stalls selling fruit, vegetables, clothing, fish, fabric, plants and other items.
