

How long do children stay at LENAP?

After a few weeks most children are ready to go to their mainstream school.

What happens when the children are ready to go to their mainstream school?

The child always visits their school before they leave LENAP. Usually they are happy with a two-day visit. Sometimes they like to go to their school a few times before they are happy.

How do I register my child at LENAP?

Your child's school will telephone LENAP to check that there is a place for your child. If there is a place, you can come to LENAP and see what we do.

If you like it, you can register your child straight away. We can help you fill in the forms.

Who goes to LENAP?

LENAP is for children who have just come to England and need help with their English.

Some children speak no English at all.

Other children have learnt some English in their own country but are worried about speaking English.
