Dear Mr Wright

Thank you for your letter of 14th August regarding the consultation on Leicestershire Minerals Development Framework and Leicestershire and Leicester Waste Development Framework. I am writing formally to object to the inclusion of Nailstone Colliery as a possible location for a waste processing operation and incinerator.

Such a scheme is totally inappropriate for the area and the potential impact on Nailstone and other villages within my constituent is unacceptable. Should Warwickshire County Council go ahead with its own site near Nuneaton, two such sites so close to each other would defy common sense. Local people are totally opposed to the use of the Nailstone Colliery Site for this purpose and I strongly support them.

It is clearly in the wrong place for such a facility and the need to transport a large quantity of waste there would cause a great deal of unnecessary disruption.

I would be grateful if my views can be taken into account.
