Introduction

The Educational Psychology Service is proud to be part of a very successful Children and Young People's Service in Leicestershire.

As part of a process of reviewing Targeted Services, the Educational Psychology Service is being reviewed. The outcomes are not known at the time of writing. However, we can expect some new ways of working and a new Service structure to be topics of discussion and consultation over the autumn term 2009. We expect that the restructured Service will be in place in the spring 2010. As part of the Work Well Strategy we expect the Service base to move to County Hall during spring 2010.

During this period of considerable change for the Service, we anticipate that a full range of services will be available as in previous years. The emphasis on multi agency working especially on behalf of children in care is retained. Psychologists continue to specialise in Early Years, Anti-Bullying, Vulnerable Pupils and School Anxiety. The education component of Family STEPs comprising Specialist Teachers and Educational Psychologists is part of the Educational Psychology Service as is the Anti-Bullying team. The Portage home visiting service remains an important part of the continuum of provision for Early Years children with significant learning difficulties.

All schools will continue to have a link psychologist but as an outcome of the review we expect there to be a greater emphasis on working with whole development groups and clusters of schools. We will continue to explore ways of providing a psychology service in community settings.

We want a Service which thrives in an atmosphere of continuous improvement so are grateful to service users who contact us with comments about the service provided and suggestions for any improvements. Please feel free to write, email or phone either of us.

What we do

The Children and Young people's Plan

All Service activities relate to priorities identified in the Children and Young People's Plan and the Targeted Services Strategic Plan.

Service Development Plan 2009 – 2010

The Service Development Plan identifies specific areas that we will focus on in the coming year. These may be new areas of work or extending existing aspects of our work. The strategic aims for our work this year are:

Be Healthy

- Lead and implement the development of TaMHS project in participating schools
- Work with Locality Co-ordinators and Specialist CAMHS
- Provide direct psychological interventions on behalf of individual CYPs at levels 2b and 3 of the Windscreen

Stay Safe

- Develop support mechanisms to reduce bullying of the disabled – initially those with an ASD
- Provide support to individual schools in response to an identified need

Enjoy and Achieve

- Participate in Service review and implement outcomes
- Provide training, coaching and mentoring to school staff e.g. contribute to the roll out of the ASD IDP
- Develop EPS presence in Children's Centres
- Review use of CAF as a mechanism for requesting EPS involvement

Making a Positive Contribution

- Work to improve parenting
- Delivering Webster Stratton programmes to families and schools
- Family support and raising awareness in schools to the needs of families with a member in prison
- Positive psychology approaches to raising happy children
- Promoting the concept of listening schools responsive to CYPs concerns and issues

Economic Well-being

- Improving outcomes for KS4 Excluded students

Ongoing Areas of Work

In addition to the areas we identify for particular development each year, a number of activities continue to form the bulk of the day-to-day work of the Service. These activities are included in the brief descriptions of each of the teams within the Service, in the 'How we work' section of this guide.

How we work

Anti Bullying Team

Bullying stops children learning and destroys confidence and emotional well being. Everyone in Leicestershire wants to see a reduction in bullying. The Educational Psychology Service leads on the Strategy to reduce bullying by creating positive, safe learning environments in which everyone has the opportunity to thrive and learn.

The Leicestershire strategy for reducing bullying has four key areas,

- Guidance, support and training for schools
- Raising awareness in schools and communities
- Leading and encouraging initiatives
- Sharing and promoting good practice locally and nationally

The team is made up of the Anti-Bullying Strategy Manager and 3 development officers (together comprising 1.0 FTE). All Educational Psychologists will respond to issues of bullying in link schools and will take a role in Anti-Bullying week in November. In addition 4 Educational Psychologists spend part of each week working in the team.

Family STEPs

The Education component of Family STEPs consists of Specialist Teachers and Educational Psychologists. The aims of the team are to provide support and advice to staff in schools and early years settings and to parents on behavioural, emotional and social issues, and to develop the skills and knowledge about children's mental health of staff working in universal services. Educational Psychologists

• Requesting involvement

Anyone can request the involvement of an Educational Psychologist with an individual pupil, with the consent of parent/carers. This can be through the completion of a consultation request form, a Common Assessment Framework referral or by letter. Parent/carers can telephone our duty line, 0116 2845100, which is staffed by senior educational psychologists. This duty line can also be used by anyone else for an urgent matter when the casework or link Educational Psychologist is not available.

The Service is also part of the Local Authority's Crisis Line. Response to Crisis Line calls to the Service will be co-ordinated by the duty Educational Psychologist.

- **Work with the Children and Young People's Service and the County Council**

The Educational Psychology Service contributes to strategy and development within the Children and Young People's Service and elsewhere. Staff contribute on issues concerned with the management of learning, teaching, mental health and emotional well being of children and young people and provide professional consultation for other departments of the County Council.

- **Community psychology and multi agency work**

There is a movement to focus services on local need. Every Child Matters emphasises the importance of agencies coming together to provide and develop effective local services for children. The Service is promoting ways in which the community around the school can access applied psychology services. We will work with others to develop new services and extend unified services for families and children.

- **Early Years work**

Educational Psychologists working in Early Years respond to requests from the Early Years Panel about young children who are likely to have additional needs on entry to school. They liaise closely with the Early Years SEN Inclusion Team, specialist and mainstream nurseries and Early Years settings to ensure that individuals' needs are identified and a plan is in place to meet those needs before school entry.

- ***The Portage Service***

This home visiting service is part of the range of provision available for young children with significant additional needs. Home Visitors work with parents to devise small steps targets for the children and activities which will help the child make progress towards these early learning goals.

- **School link work**

- ***Consultation***

The first response to any request for involvement from this Service is likely to be a conversation with the person who has the concern. The aim of this conversation will be to gather available information, to develop hypotheses about what is happening and to work out and agree ways forward.

- ***Prioritising work***

Priority for educational psychologist involvement in casework is allocated to:

- Statutory work and SENDIS Tribunals
- Children in care
- Children of primary age at risk of exclusion and/or with complex difficulties where there are significant barriers to learning
- Children and young people at risk of permanent exclusion
- Children involved in bullying
- Work in primary schools, on the grounds of early intervention.

When schools wish to raise concerns about an individual child a consultation request form should usually be completed. Not all consultation request forms will automatically trigger an educational psychologist visit to the school. Where possible, educational psychologists will have initial involvement via a phone consultation. Many consultation request forms will not result in an individual assessment of the child's needs. The agreements reached as a result of a phone consultation will be noted in the child's EPS file or in a short confirming letter to the school or another person who has raised the concern. Copies of these letters will be sent to parent/carers unless there is a good reason not to do so.

An intervention by an educational psychologist need not necessarily result in a report. The emphasis is on effective communication and learning. When an educational psychologist feels a written report is the form of communication most likely to bring about improvement for a child, this will be brief and may use headings such as; reason for involvement, work undertaken, recommendations/action points agreed and follow up. Such reports are quicker to prepare and are easier to read. Copies of reports will be sent to parent/carers unless there is a good reason not to do so.

- **Training**
EPs, Anti Bullying and Family STEPs staff provide training for professionals and parents on a wide variety of topics. Bespoke packages can be compiled for individual schools or whole development groups on request. Such training is usually chargeable unless the work can be funded from another source.

Clerical and Administration Team

The team provides a range of secretarial services to designated professional staff. Work includes typing statutory reports, the preparation of resources and diary management using a range of software. The team effectively channels confidential issues and matters of concern raised by members of the public. They are involved in maintaining all records related to the work of the Service and welfare of our staff, operating both electronic and manual systems.
