**Community Strategy & Leicestershire Local Strategic Partnership LLSP** –

Nicole Rickard (LCC) handed out an summary of where the LLSP and it's Community Strategy (CS) is and the process that has been involved in producing it. (See sheet)

The CS will be considered by the County Council on July 9<sup>th</sup> and will be published by the end of July.

A report on the monitoring of the CS and the use of indicators will be going to the LLSP in September.

Nicole explained the two stages of consultation for the CS and how ENABLE's comments were considered, (original ENABLE response to the CS was circulated with the agenda).

Very few of the comment made by ENABLE were included in the final draft.

The issue of incorporating actions and targets from other Strategies was discussed and it was felt that generic actions that could be incorporated into the CS should be produced and that strategies could be presented to the LLSP to show what was happening in different partner organisation.

**Feedback from attendance at LLSP** – in Sally ? absence it was made clear that she had put across the importance of environmental issues at the two meetings that she attended. Notes of each meeting were circulated with the agenda.

**ENABLE Environmental Statement & setting priorities for action, report from Sub-Group -**

Karl reported back on the work of the sub group via a one page summary of the out comes.

The general framework of what the Statement should include was agreed along with the list of headings to be covered. It was noted that this was a priority list of issues affecting Leicestershire.

The work programme was also considered (and the impact of the revised CS) and it was proposed to set up various sub groups to tackle different areas of the statement.

The sub group has agreed to me on the ? July to consider the environmental statement.
