



An example of the Safer Travel Presentation for High School pupils

- Section 1: Waiting for the bus

**What to do:**

- ✓ Try and arrive at the bus stop 5 minutes before your bus is due to arrive.
- ✓ Wait sensibly at the bus stop.
- ✓ Have your bus pass ready to show the driver.
- ✓ Stand back as the bus approaches the bus stop.
- ✓ Take care when boarding the bus, don't push or shove.

- **Section 2: Travelling on the bus**

**What to do:**

- ✓ Find a seat and sit down.
- ✓ Put on your seatbelt, if one is provided.
- ✓ Stay in your seat for the whole journey. Remain sat forward with your feet on the floor.
- ✓ Don't block the aisle, seats or exits with your bags.
- ✓ Don't be too noisy, you may distract the driver.

- **Section 3: Pupils watch a short video clip about a 12 year old boy who was killed in an accident as a result of pupils distracting the bus driver.** (Includes TV news footage and interviews with a Solicitor, a Fireman and an A & E Consultant.)

- **Section 4: Getting off the bus**

**What to do:**

- ✓ Don't leave your seat until the bus has stopped.
- ✓ Don't rush for the door when the bus has stopped.
- ✓ Be aware of other traffic when getting off the bus.
- ✓ Wait until the bus has driven away before crossing the road.

- **Section 5: 'Spare a thought for the bus driver!'**  
***Pupils watch a short video that looks at poor behaviour on the school bus through a bus driver's eyes and what sort of affect it has upon their job.***

- **Section 6: Promotion of our on-line reporting form.**
