To IEP or not to IEP - Effective systems for IEPs

Aims:

IEPS can be an area of unnecessary paperwork and duplication. IEPs are not a statutory requirement. Where schools have a policy of individual planning and recording for **all** pupils then pupils with SEN may not need an IEP. Such schools would have robust systems for tracking and reviewing all pupils' progress and an effective provision map outlining the 'additional or different' provision in place linked to SEN pupils' needs.

This course considers how to streamline IEP processes. It will look at examples of good practice and provide opportunities to share good practice with other Sencos.
