Risk Assessment for Indoor Nursery Rhyme Day

Hazard	Who is affected?	Control Measures
General: Traffic Stream Trees	Children and adults	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See General Site Risk Assessment sheets • Verbal warnings given to whole group during introduction to the day's activities
In the Cellars - General: Heavy fire doors Uneven floors Fire regulations	Children and adults	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults to open and close fire doors • Walk at all times in Cellar passageways • Verbal instructions given to adults. Each leader carries written instructions
Station 1: Stairs	Children and adults	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All must proceed in single line using hand rail
Station 2: Victorian equipment in Linen Room	Children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults monitor use of Victorian equipment. Handle with care, consideration and common sense.
Station 3: Water pump, irons, mangle and equipment in Laundry	Children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults monitor use of Victorian equipment. Handle with care, consideration and common sense. • Children are warned to be very careful with the irons as they are very heavy. • The mangle is inoperative
Station 4: Victorian equipment in Kitchen Oven doors Glassware	Children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults monitor use of Victorian equipment. Handle with care, consideration and common sense. • Oven doors demonstrated by adults. • Children are asked not to touch the glass and pottery – the reason is explained.
Station 5: Desk seats in Victorian Schoolroom Equipment	Children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be aware of <u>possible</u> finger-trapping • Adults monitor Victorian equipment. Handle with care, consideration and common sense.
Station 6: See Outdoor Notes, Indoor use	Children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See notes on equipment use outside • Be aware of <u>possible</u> wet and slippery surface of base room floor
