Hazard	Who is affected	Control Measures
<p><u>Activity 1</u> In the woods</p> <p>Logs – seats Losing sight Skips, trips, falls</p>	Children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Check for stability, sharp protrusions ▪ Give boundaries beyond which children must not venture ▪ Remind children to move carefully
<p><u>Activity 2</u> Log pile</p> <p>Logs Berries “Forest raisins”</p>	Children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Supervise careful and suitable climbing ▪ Do not take samples from the trees ▪ Warn the children not to eat anything picked up from the ground
<p><u>Activity 3</u> Adventure play area</p> <p>Off-set gate Chainbridge Scramble net Tyres</p>	Children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Warn children to only use apparatus in designated work area ▪ Curb racing ▪ Avoid hitting head ▪ Suggest two hands to hold chain – beware of feet slipping off ▪ Beware of possible rope burns ▪ Place feet carefully – be aware of slipping on rope ▪ Watch for possible friction burns ▪ Supervise climbing through tyres – be aware of “personal” injuries

Hazard	Who is affected	Control Measures
<p><u>Activity 4</u> Bear Hunt</p> <p>Losing sight of children Slope Rabbit holes</p>	<p>Children</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Explain boundaries within the area beyond which children must not venture ▪ Gentle horizontal roll down the slope only ▪ Look out for
<p><u>Activity 5</u> Mini-Beast Hunt</p> <p>Branches of trees Berries, “forest raisins” Inside large tree</p>	<p>Children</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Gentle shaking of trees under supervision ▪ Remind children not to put anything found on the ground into their mouths ▪ Only allow exploration and tree climbing under strict supervision
