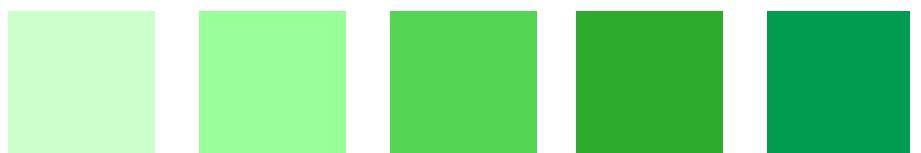

# Leicestershire Small Area Population and Household Estimates 2001-2004



## Purpose

To make available small area household and population estimates for all current parishes / settlements, wards and lower super output areas (LSOAs)<sup>1</sup> in Leicestershire between 2001 and 2004.

## Summary

The Leicestershire small area population estimates for 2004 show that the largest settlements in the County were Loughborough (57,600), Hinckley (38,600) and Coalville (32,000). There were 34 settlements in the county with an estimated population of over 5,000 (see Table 2). These figures relate to a mid-year population estimate for 2004 for Leicestershire of 623,900.

The settlements to have the largest estimated population increase between 2001 and 2004 were Loughborough (1,900), Coalville (1,300), Market Harborough (1,000) and Hinckley (900). Proportionately, the settlements with at least 1,000 people to have the largest relative estimated change were Bagworth and Thornton (17.5%), Lutterworth (7.9%), Sileby (7.8%), Great Glen (6.9%) and Oakthorpe and Donisthorpe (6.8%).

The results of lower super output area estimates show there is wide range (from -2.2% to 31.6%) in the percentage population change across the county and within some large settlements between 2001 and 2004 (see Figure 1).

<sup>1</sup> Lower super output areas are a relatively new geography created by ONS for the 2001 Census and consist of approximately 1,500 people.

## Results

### Parishes / Settlements

Table 1 shows the estimated change between 2001 and 2004 in the largest parishes / settlements in Leicestershire (over 5,000 people). The largest absolute changes estimated were in Loughborough (1,900 people), Coalville (1,300 people) and Market Harborough (1,000) settlements.

## Wards

Table 2 provides a list of the wards in Leicestershire with the largest absolute estimated population increase between 2001 and 2004. The largest estimated population increases between 2001 and 2004 were in Hinckley Clarendon (890), Winstanley (670), Market Harborough Little Bowden (660) and Loughborough Southfields (600) wards.

Table 3 shows the wards in Leicestershire with the largest estimated percentage change in population between 2001 and 2004. The largest estimated percentage increases in population have been in Lutterworth Swift (18.5%), Market Harborough Little Bowden (14.6%), Bardon (13.0%) and Broughton Astley Broughton (12.6%) wards.

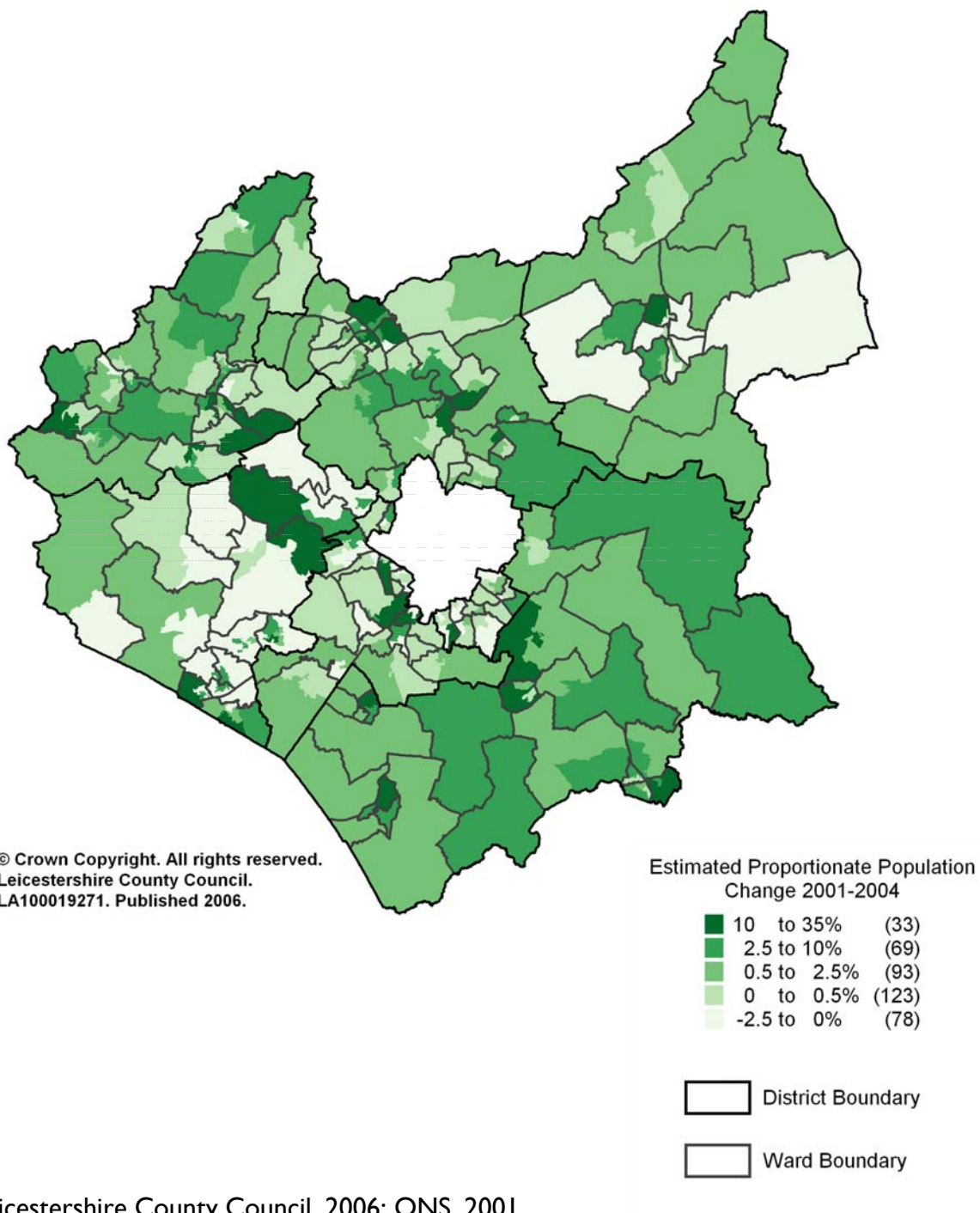

*Lower Super Output Areas*

Figure 1 shows the estimated percentage change between 2001 and 2004 for the 396 Leicestershire lower super output areas. The areas with the largest estimated percentage change (from 10% to 35%) are shown in the darkest shade. The areas in the lightest shade have estimated to have had no population increase or a reduction in the population of up to 2.5% between 2001 and 2004. The map shows the smaller areas within large settlements where population change has been most notable. Some areas within large settlements, for example, Melton Mowbray and Hinckley, show population loss between 2001 and 2004.

## Method

The method used to estimate the household and population change was to apply net dwelling stock change in an area to the base household and population data from the 2001 Census. Dwelling change data are based on data collected for the Leicestershire Annual Residential Land Monitoring Report compiled by the County Council. This data is supplied by individual districts within Leicestershire. The results for the population and household estimates were adjusted to ensure that the population estimates add up to the ONS Local Authority District Mid-Year Population Estimates.

Table 4 provides an overview of the household and population estimation procedure and notes.

Dwelling stock change collected from the Leicestershire Annual Residential Land Monitoring Report is net new dwellings, conversions and changes of use. Allocation to settlement for large and small sites is mostly provided by district supplying data. Grid references were used to allocate completions to lower super output area level, with an element of estimation. Quality checks with other information sources improved the allocation of changes at small area level.

The methodology assumes that the net number of additional households is the same as the net change in dwelling stock. It also assumes a consistent household size for the net number of additional

households across the county. Changes in student accommodation are not included in these estimates, and changes in the communal establishment population are also not included

ONS District Mid Year Estimates are used as the control for the adjustment factor to give consistency with figures used elsewhere.

## Example Workings

A working example of the 2002 population estimation procedure for the imaginary parish of “Littleham” is shown below:

### *Factors*

- 2001 Census base resident population = 2,000
- Number of dwelling completed 2001-2002 = 5
- Leicestershire 2001 Census average household size = 2.43
- Leicestershire 2002 projected average household size = 2.416
- District ONS 2002 mid-year estimate (MYE) = 75,000
- 2001 Census communal establishment population = 10
- District 2001 Census communal establishment population = 1,000
- District sum of 2002 household resident estimates = 80,000

### *Estimation procedure*

Adjusted average household size ratio =  $2.416/2.43 = 0.993$

Household resident estimate =  $(2,000 * 0.993) + (5 * 2.416) = 1998.08$

District level adjustment control =  $(80,000) / (75,000 - 1,000) = 1.081$

Adjusted household resident estimate =  $1998.08 * 1.081 = 2159.924$

Adjusted population estimate =  $2175.22 + 10 = 2169.924$

Final population estimate adjusted population estimated rounded to nearest ten = 2,170

The procedure was repeated for consecutive years using the previous year’s household resident estimates. The same methodology was used to calculate parish and lower super output area estimates. Lower super output area estimates were aggregated to ward level to produce ward estimates.

## Geography of small areas

Parishes are those for which census headcount data is available, i.e. those legally in force at the end of 2002. All the population within the parish boundary is counted. Settlements include the unparished areas of Loughborough, Market Harborough, Hinckley, Melton Mowbray, Coalville, Oadby, South Wigston and Wigston.

Wards are census wards, i.e. district electoral wards in force at the end of 2002. Ward boundaries do not always correspond with similarly named parish/settlement boundaries.

Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs) are aggregations of 2001 Census Output Areas. LSOAs subdivide census wards, and are frequently used in other statistical output.

## Parish/Settlement geography notes

- 1 In Charnwood District, Loughborough (unparished) and Hathern parish combined correspond almost to the sum of Loughborough wards
- 2 Market Harborough (unparished) and Great Bowden parish combined correspond almost to the sum of Market Harborough wards.
- 3 Hinckley settlement (unparished) includes Hinckley wards and Barwell ward
- 4 Melton Mowbray (unparished) is almost the sum of its wards
- 5 In North West Leicestershire District, Ashby de la Zouch parish includes Blackfordby (part of Moira ward)
- 6 In North West Leicestershire District, Coalville (unparished) includes wards of Coalville, Whitwick, Thringstone, and part of wards of Greenhill (excluding Charley parish), Hugglescote (excluding Ellistown and Battleflat parish), Bardon (excluding Bardon parish) and Snibston (excluding The Limes part of Ravenstone parish)
