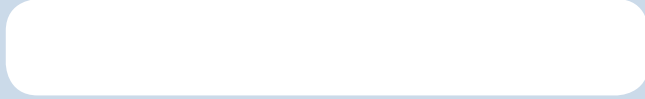

Who are we?

We are a group of people who act as a 'communications channel', engaging with organisations that provide services for older people throughout Leicestershire, in order to inform and improve local services.

Most of our members belong to other local groups and networks, such as: Hinckley Older Voices Forum, Leicestershire & Rutland Ethnic Minority Forum, Oadby & Wigston Seniors Forum, U3A Countesthorpe, Blaby Older Person's Forum and U3A Melton.

We come together to form Leicestershire 'O.P.E.N.', to represent different views around the county.

Who are we supported by?

Leicestershire County Council, Leicestershire and Rutland Primary Care Trust, CVS Community Partnership, Age Concern Leicestershire and Rutland, District and Borough Councils all support O.P.E.N. Administrative support is also provided for the group.

How will we do this?

- We will connect with the many existing groups and forums in Leicestershire, who represent older people throughout the districts and link issues into the wider County Council planning processes.
- By using the 'Better Government for Older People' (BGOP) principles, which:
 - Aim to increase the profile of older people
 - Ensure that older people's diverse voices are reflected in policies and services
 - Ensure that older people's contributions are encouraged and recognised.

Why are we doing this?

We are doing this to:

- Consult with older people throughout Leicestershire, which is a key priority for statutory agencies.
- Ensure that local people play a full and active role in shaping local services
- Make a difference to the local policies and plans

Who can join?

Anyone over the age of 50 living in Leicestershire, who would like to make a positive contribution to the well being of older people.
