

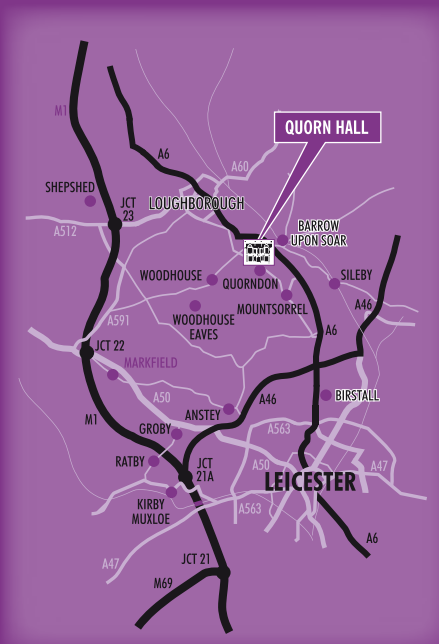
HOW TO FIND US

Approaching from the North

Exit the M1 motorway at Junction 23. Turn left onto the A512 (Ashby Road) towards Loughborough. At the 2nd roundabout turn right onto the A6004 (Epinal Way). Continue straight ahead until you reach the 5th roundabout. At this roundabout turn right (3rd exit) towards Quorn on the Loughborough Road. Turn left at the 1st set of traffic lights onto Farley Way. At the 1st roundabout take the 3rd exit along Meynell Road towards Quorn. The entrance to Quorn Hall is approximately 400 metres on the left.

Approaching from the South

Exit the M1 motorway at Junction 21A along the A46 towards Newark. Leave the A46 at the Birstall exit (approx. 5 miles from the M1 Junction at 21A). Turn left on the A6 towards Loughborough. Proceed to the 2nd exit showing Quorn (situated immediately after the 2nd road bridge over the A6). Take the 2nd exit at the roundabout and proceed along Meynell Road. The entrance to Quorn Hall is approximately 400 metres on the left.

LOCATION

Quorn Hall International Centre is a large country house built during the reign of Charles II and stands in 12 acres of mature landscaped gardens with the River Soar flowing through the grounds. It is located in the historic Leicestershire village of Quorndon (Quorn) approximately 2 miles (3 kilometres) south of the old market town of Loughborough.

FACILITIES

Visitors to Quorn Hall enjoy a warm and friendly environment. Facilities include study rooms, general meeting rooms, a games room and a television room along with outdoor amenities, such as volleyball, football, chess, boule and badminton. The Hall is situated in the heart of England and is an ideal base for educational day visits to a number of places of interest e.g. Stratford upon Avon, York and London.

CATERING

The catering at Quorn Hall is a speciality, with all meals cooked and prepared in it's own kitchen. There are two main dining rooms able to accommodate up to 120 visitors for breakfast, lunch and evening meal. The Farnham Dining room looks out onto the beautiful gardens of Quorn Hall.

CONFERENCE FACILITIES

Quorn Hall is able to offer conference facilities for groups of up to 45 for educational meetings and seminars. Rooms can be arranged in different styles and audio / visual facilities are also available. A 2mb broadband internet link to the embc network is available by prior arrangement at an additional cost.

RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION

Quorn Hall has centrally heated and carpeted accommodation for 120 visitors. There are 25 bedrooms, of which 17 rooms are arranged in dormitories for 4 - 10 people and 8 are twin bedded rooms with en-suite facilities. The accommodation is situated on three floors, with separate bathroom facilities for males and females on each floor. Bed linen is provided and there are storage facilities for personal belongings. Tea-making facilities are provided in the twin bedded rooms. A bedroom suite on the ground floor is available for visitors with disabilities.
