Sport England is keen to encourage increased opportunities for sport and active recreational activities and to have an opportunity to comment on the relevant documents in the LDF.

You advised, however, that this is intended to be covered by core strategy and dc policies document. On this basis I have made no specific comments in response to this consultation. I also appreciate that many of these sites are on industrial areas and relate to treatment of waste. I would, however, encourage you to consult us about future policies that do relate to after use so that we can advocate beneficial after uses for sport.
