

## **TREE MANAGEMENT POLICY NO. 1 – TREE INSPECTION**

The County Council's tree inspection programme takes into account the criteria and procedures detailed in Section 1 of the Tree Management Strategy.

The County Council meet the following targets of inspection frequency : -

### **TREES IN THE HIGHWAY AND ADJACENT PRIVATELY OWNED TREES**

Strategic Routes, Main Distributor Roads, Secondary Distributor Roads and Locally Important Roads -

Routine Inspections by Highway Inspectors	Every year
Specialist Inspections by Tree Inspector	Every two years

All Other Roads -

Routine Inspections by Highway Inspectors	Every year
Specialist Inspections by Tree Inspector	Every four years

### **SCHOOLS**

Routine Inspections by Site Staff	Every year
Specialist Inspections by Tree Inspector	Every three years

### **ADULT AND YOUNG PERSON CARE PREMISES**

Routine Inspections by Site Staff	Every year
Specialist Inspections by Tree Inspector	Every three years

### **COUNTRY PARKS**

Areas of high use -

Routine Inspections by Rangers	Every year
Specialist Inspections by Tree Inspector	Every three years

Other Areas -

Routine Inspections by Rangers	Every year
Specialist Inspections by Tree Inspector	As requested

### **COUNTY COUNCIL WOODLANDS**

Adjacent to access routes -

Walked Inspection by Tree Inspector	Every three years
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
