Leicestershire County Council has prepared this statement to comply with the requirements in Regulation 24 (4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 and gives notice that Leicestershire County Council adopted the Leicestershire Minerals Core Strategy and Development Control Policies document and Leicester City Council and Leicestershire County Council adopted the Leicestershire and Leicester Waste Core Strategy and Development Control Policies document – part of the Leicestershire Minerals and Waste Development Framework on 8th October 2009.

The documents set out the vision, objectives, spatial strategy and development control policies for minerals development in Leicestershire and for waste development in Leicester and Leicestershire up to 2021.

Any person aggrieved by the Leicestershire Minerals Core Strategy and Development Control Policies document and/or the Leicestershire and Leicester Waste Core Strategy and Development Control Policies document(s) may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that: the document is not within the appropriate power; or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Such an application must be made no later than the end of the six week period starting on the above adoption date (Regulation 24 (4) (b & c)).
