Leicestershire County Council has submitted to the Secretary of State its Minerals Development Framework Core Strategy and Development Control Policies document and, in conjunction with Leicester City Council the Waste Development Framework Core Strategy and Development Control Policies document. The documents set out the vision, objectives and spatial strategy for minerals development in Leicestershire and for waste development in Leicester and Leicestershire up to 2021. The documents are accompanied by Sustainability Reports assessing the potential social, environmental, and economic effects of the documents.

The submitted documents will be examined by an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. Representations may be made on the submitted documents and will be passed to the Inspector and taken into account in producing the final documents.
