Minerals and Waste Development Framework
Comments from Woodhouse Parish Council

1. Waste

Woodhouse Council's view is that the strategy looks very sensible and workable except for:

" in exceptional circumstances land in Green Wedges and agricultural land is not to be precluded."

The Council would like a definition of what the exceptional circumstances might be that could mean Green Wedges and agricultural land are used.

The Council does not believe there are any circumstances to justify using Green Wedges and agricultural land for this type of use either locally in or near this Parish. There must be brown field sites that are available which are nearer to population areas and would thus minimise the amount of traffic that would be generated to a more distant rural location, and also avoid spoiling attractive countryside.

2. Minerals
